Since 2014, Update on Hepatology has grown into a leading scientific and educational event in Romania, bringing together international and national experts, clinicians, researchers, and

Importantly, we also open the conversation beyond traditional clinical endpoints through HepaHUB: Connecting with Our Patients, including a dedicated focus on Patient-Reported Outcomes in liver care, because the patient's voice should be a core part of modern hepatology practice.

We are grateful to our faculty for shaping such a clinically meaningful program, to our partners for their support, and to all of you for being part of this community. We hope you will find these two days stimulating, interactive, and immediately applicable to your daily practice and that you will leave inspired to bring personalized hepatology into the natural flow of care for every patient.

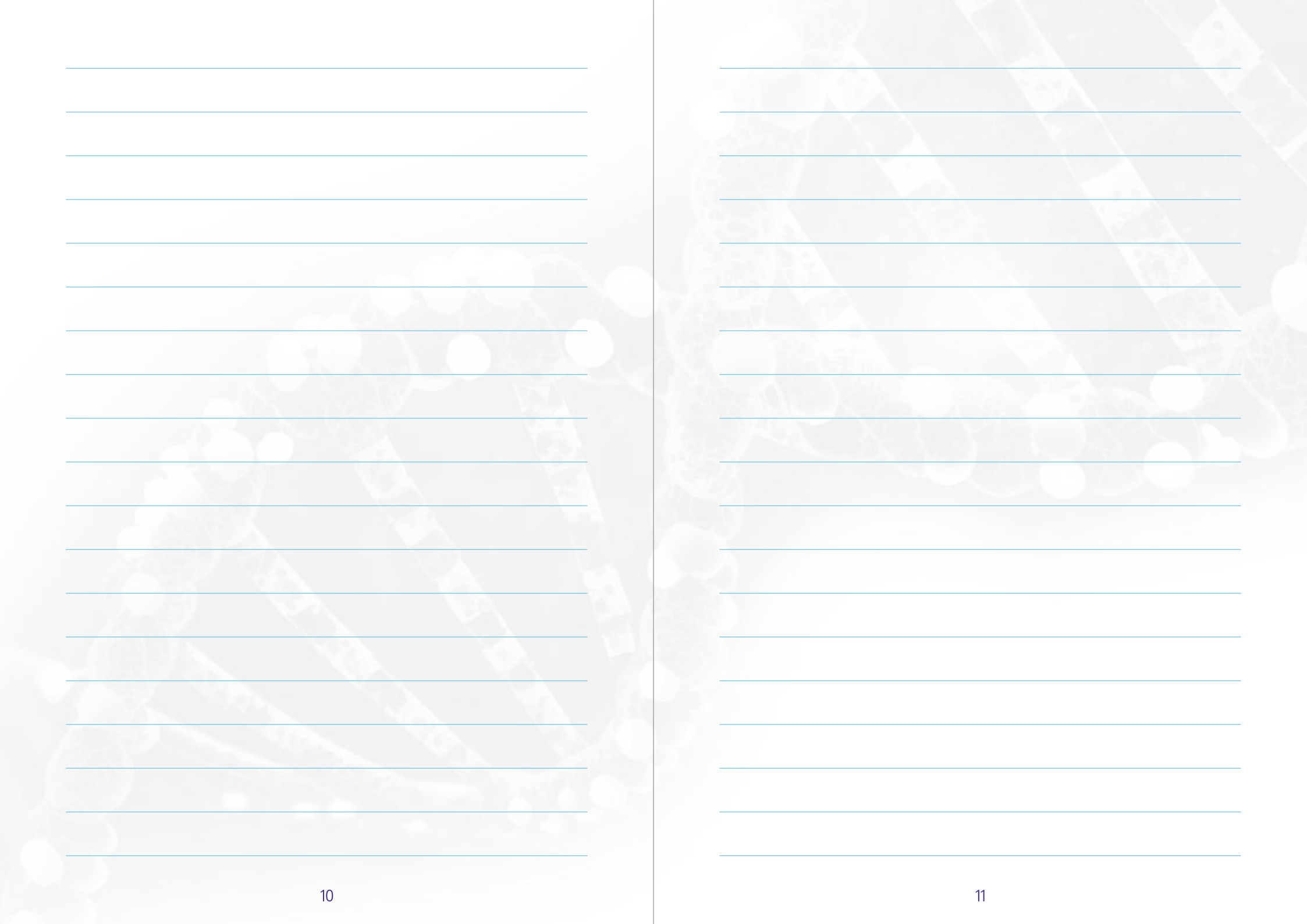
